SOUTH AFRICA'S TERROR TRIALS

On Monday 2 August two trials commence in South Africa.

The Very Reverend Gonville ffrench-Beytagh, Anglican Dean of Johannesburg, appears in the Pretoria Supreme Court on charges under South Africa's notorious all-embracing Terrorism Act. And in the Pietermaritzburg Supreme Court 14 Africans, Indians & Coloureds - detained since February this year in solitary confinement - appear on charges under this same Act. Their arrest, detention and forthcoming trial have as yet received little attention.

Thus the apartheid regime's persecution of those who oppose its racist policies continues.
