Eight South African patriots have been jailed for life for their part in the struggle against race oppression .....

- NELSON MANDELA : former underground leader of the African National Congress
- WALTER SISULU : former Secretary-General of the A.N.C.
- GOVAN MBEKI : resistance leader from the Transkei
- AHMED KATHRADA : of the South African Indian Congress
- DENNIS GOLDBERG : former Congress of Democrats leader
- RAYMOND MHLABA : went underground to carry on the struggle
- ANDREW MLANGENI : former ANC branch secretary
- ELIAS MOTSOALEDI : trade unionist, chairman of former Council of Non-European Trade Unions (forerunner of SACTU)

When these men pleaded from the dock, they all admitted their part in furthering the illegal struggle against apartheid. But they all pleaded NOT GUILTY - THE GUILT IS THE SOUTH AFRICAN GOVERNMENT'S.

These men have sacrificed their freedom for a vision of a free South Africa, where all races shall live together in peace. Their ideal is the ideal of all us, their struggle ours. We must not rest until these savage sentences are revoked, and all South African political prisoners are free.
