**S**EPTEMBER 30 is the first anniversary of the UN-monitored multi-party elections which were meant to usher in a new era of peace and democracy for the Angolan people. However, the losing party – Jonas Savimbi's Unita – has since launched a vicious terror war to overturn the results of the ballot box and gain power by force.

Over a hundred thousand people have died as a result. Nearly three million are displaced and living as refugees after fleeing from Unita's terror. The UN estimate direct and indirect casualties are running at 1000 per day, in what has been described as the worst war in the world.

The added tragedy of Angola is that this war has been largely forgotten by the media and political circles in the West. This makes it harder to secure decisive international action to isolate and deter Unita from its war.

This Rally is part of a Fortnight of Solidarity to break the silence about Angola, draw the attention of public opinion to the need to defend peace and democracy in Angola, and mobilise to stop the terror and tragedy inflicted upon the Angolan people.
