

STOP APARTHEID EXECUTIONS

The Sharpeville Six are awaiting execution because of the law of 'common purpose' which makes all those present at the scene of any mass action where a law is broken guilty of the same offence. The field is made wide open to agents provocateur!

45 men and 2 women are known to be on death row in Pretoria resulting from actions taken against collaborators, informers and vigilantes.

Remember Bejamin Moloise. Hanged October 18, 1985. Remember Tshepo Litsoare. Hanged March 18, 1988. Remember Michael Lukas. Hanged March 25, 1988

7 trained guerilla fighters of Umkhonto we Sizwe (the armed wing of the African National Congress) have been judicially murdered by the South African regime. They were all entitled to Prisoner of War status in terms of the Geneva Conventions.

Remember Solomon Mahlangu. Hanged April 6, 1979.

Remember Marcus Motaung, Jerry Mosololi, Simon Mogoerane. Hanged June 9, 1983.

Remember Clarence Payi, Sipho Xulu, Andrew Zondo. Hanged September 9, 1986.
