NELSON MANDELA -FREEDOM AT 70

On June 12th 1964 Nelson Mandela was sentenced to life imprisonment for his part in leading the struggles of the South African people against apartheid.

This year, on July 18th, he will spend his 70th birthday in South Africa's Pollsmoor Prison.



On June 12th 1986 the South African government declared a draconian State of Emergency in order to crush the continuing struggles of the people.

This year the South African Government has imposed new restrictions, effectively banning 17 democratic organisations and attacking the giant Congress of South African Trade Unions.

The Namibian people face the same repression under South African occupation. Their Trade Union federation; the National Union of Namibian Workers, faces constant harassment and persecution.
