On Sunday 21st December in Trafalgar Square from 5-7pm the Anti-Apartheid Movement is staging **Carols for Liberation.** You are invited to join the London Community Gospel Choir in the singing of carols and songs in support of the freedom struggle in South Africa and Namibia. The Choirs of the liberation movements, ANC and SWAPO, will lead the singing.

This freedom struggle needs your support:

- ☆ More than 20,000 people have been detained in South Africa during the current State of Emergency including children as young as nine years old.
- ☆ Namibia is under illegal military occupation by more than 100,000 South African troops who have instigated a 'reign of terror' against the Namibian people.
- ☆ South Africa's largest internal anti-apartheid organisation the United Democratic Front have called for the Christmas period between the 16th and the 26th December to be marked by increased protests against the State of Emergency.
- ☆ The religious community in Southern Africa have increasingly come under attack by the regime as people of faith resist the brutality and injustices of apartheid.
