APARTHEID'S WAR

South Africa exports apartheid to neighbouring Namibia. Namibia is occupied by over 100,000 South African troops. As Namibia's population is only just over one million, this is one of the most intense military occupations in history. Namibia's liberation movement, SWAPO, is brutally suppressed. SWAPO leaders are imprisoned and tortured.

From Namibia, South Africa launches its attacks on Angola. Parts of Angola are occupied by South Africa.

Mozambique, too, is suffering from South Africa's war against freedom in Africa.

WHY SANCTIONS?

The African National Congress of South Africa and SWAPO of Namibia have called for sanctions (bans on trade, investment etc.) to help their struggle for freedom and justice.

The British government opposes sanctions, claiming that they do not work. Why, then, were sanctions imposed on Vietnam, Poland, Afghanistan and other countries whose policies are disliked by our government?

The ANC says "Sanctions will weaken the apartheid regime which will mean fewer lives lost in the battle that is being waged. The lifespan of apartheid will be shortened - this will be your vital contribution to our freedom struggle."

Ever since it handed over power to the white minority in 1910, Britain has been a major investor in South Africa. It is essential that Britain imposes sanctions and stops backing the apartheid regime.

WHAT IS APARTHEID?

Apartheid is the system of oppression and exploitation in South Africa. It is based on racism.

- * Whites in South Africa (15% of the population) own 87% of the land and enjoy one of the highest standards of living in the world. Africans are forced to live in segregated "homelands" and are robbed of their basic human rights.
- * African wages are, on average, less than a quarter of White wages. Over four million Africans are unemployed.
- * While white children have good food and health care, 50,000 African children die of malnutrition each year.
- * Since June 1986, over 20,000 people have been detained under the emergency regulations. Children, as well as adults, are tortured in detention.
