Yet South Africa is still not free from racial tyranny. The South African authorities have not yet dismantled the pillars of apartheid which sustain the systematic repression of the majority black population.

Young people and students have always borne the brunt of oppressive apartheid legislation, and they have been - and remain - the most militant and heroic formation in the democratic struggle. It is essential that students in this country continue to support their struggle.
